



Town Hall Bridge Club at Wade Day Centre

Are you a bridge player looking for somewhere to play in the evening?

If so, then the “Town Hall Bridge Club” (Duplicate bridge) who now play at WADE is looking for new members!

The following information may help you decide:

- This is a club for people who know how to play bridge (there is no teaching) but enjoy “social” bridge. None of us are expert bridge players, but we are a very friendly bunch! The club is not affiliated to the EBU.
- We play on Tuesday evenings, starting promptly at 7.00pm. The number of boards played varies according to the number of tables we have, but 24 is the maximum. We therefore finish at different times, but it’s normally between 9.15pm - 9.45pm.
- We have to rearrange the room a bit and shuffle the cards before we start, both done by the people who arrive first.
- Wade is conveniently placed in the town centre so you can walk, bike or drive. Parking is available on site in Wade’s car park.
- We charge £3 per head per night and there is an annual membership fee of £10 per head. People don't have to have a partner. When an uneven number of people turn up, one person (the 'host') has to go home.
